5.	Paul-Otto Ströbel summarized the past racing season.	
6.	Paul-Otto Ströbel reported from the WMCR board meeting on the previous day. Topics discussed included the introduction of electric cars, possibilities to raise new members as well as the technical constraints regarding a further diameter increase of 10cc cables. No decisions have been made regarding those topics. The USA made the proposal to hold WC every year instead of every three years; this has been rejected by the WMCR board. Due to a lack of resources the USA is not able to host the WC 2016 therefore the venue is yet to be determined.	
7.	Peter Arlautzki elaborated about the financial performance during the period from August 2012 to July 2013 and informed the delegates about the current financial situation. All countries have paid for the country and license fees in 2013.	
8.	Heinz Bach (CH) and Sylvia Bach (CH) have been elected as Auditors prior to the general meeting.	
9.	Heinz Bach and Sylvia Bach have audited the FEMA accounts for the period from August 2012 to July 2013 prior to the general meeting. They found everything in order; the books were kept clearly and without any recognizable errors.

14.2.	Clarification the format and process for proposals. FEMA board will define a clear process and template for proposal prior to general meeting 2014.	Approved (12/0/0),

15.1.	In the course of the change of the official language the FEMA board will prepare revised statutes also adjusting other outdated content. New statutes shall be approved at the general meeting 2014.
