The Castrol Trophy is awarded to the car (from any class) recording the fastest speed of the day. It was donated to the QMRCC in 1963 and was first won by Doug Harding with a speed 129.45 miles/hr (\approx 208.33 km/hr).

This year's Castrol Trophy was won by Tony Peacock with a speed of 333.456 km/hr
